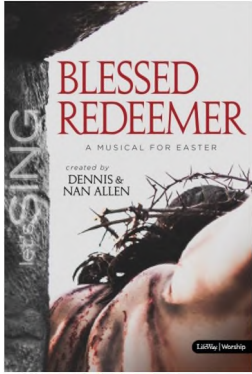

John 18:28-40

Main Idea: Unbelief

1. Pilate questions Jesus' claim of being a king. V28-33
2. Our Lord's kingdom. V34-37.
3. Pilate questions what real truth is? V38
4. Pilate knew it was wrong to kill Jesus, but did it anyway. V39-40
