





#### **Canned Food Drive**

#### Suggested ideas for "food box" contents

# Please make sure there is at least three months shelf life remaining and cans have POP TABS

- Canned soups (no broth or "cream of"), canned pasta
- Canned vegetables: (soup, green beans, corn, peas, potatoes)
- ♦ Canned protein/meat: (chicken, tuna, salmon)
- ♦ Canned fruit: (mandarin oranges, pineapple, peaches, pears, mixed fruit, applesauce)
- ♦ Microwave popcorn
- Snacks: Granola bars-chocolate chip, Crackers
   (Ritz, Peanut Butter crackers, etc.)
- ♦ Peanut butter (creamy), jelly
- ♦ Spaghetti noodles and Spaghetti sauce (jar/can)
- Boxed macaroni and cheese and/or pasta salad
- ♦ Cereal, Quaker oatmeal (box of individual packets), grits
- Muffin mix packets that only require water
- ♦ Bottled water
- ♦ Toilet Paper
- ♦ Paper Towels
- Personal care: Bar of soap (unscented), shampoo/ conditioner, laundry detergent, baby diapers, pull ups, Adult diapers, toilet paper, toothpaste
