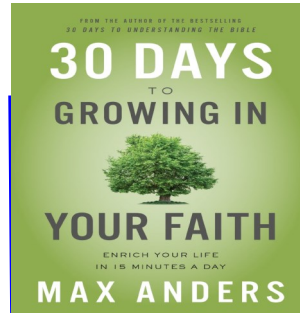

These will be distributed to shut-ins on Sept. 21. **Lunch at 12 Noon** followed by crafts. Pumpkins go to homebound.



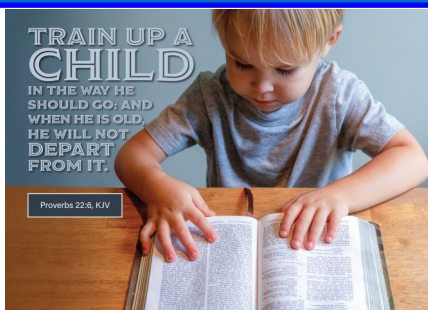

Canned Food Drive

Suggested ideas for “food box” contents

Please make sure there is at least three months shelf life remaining and cans have POP TABS

- ◇ Canned soups (no broth or “cream of”), canned pasta
- ◇ Canned vegetables: (soup, green beans, corn, peas, potatoes)
- ◇ Canned protein/meat: (chicken, tuna, salmon)
- ◇ Canned fruit: (mandarin oranges, pineapple, peaches, pears, mixed fruit, applesauce)
- ◇ Microwave popcorn
- ◇ Snacks: Granola bars-chocolate chip, Crackers (Ritz, Peanut Butter crackers, etc.)
- ◇ Peanut butter (creamy), jelly
- ◇ Spaghetti noodles and Spaghetti sauce (jar/can)
- ◇ Boxed macaroni and cheese and/or pasta salad
- ◇ Cereal, Quaker oatmeal (box of individual packets), grits
- ◇ Muffin mix packets that only require water
- ◇ Bottled water
- ◇ Toilet Paper
- ◇ Paper Towels
- ◇ Personal care: Bar of soap (unscented), shampoo/conditioner, laundry detergent, baby diapers, pull ups, Adult diapers, toilet paper, toothpaste
