Shoebox gifts delight the hearts of boys and girls in more than 100 countries where Samaritan's Purse local partners deliver the

shoeboxes along with the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. You may wish to pack an actual box or contribute funds to help us purchase items for boxes! We once again have special handmade hats for you to include in your box. All funds should be given by November 16 (note OCC on your check/envelope-made to HBC).

Completed, properly labeled boxes should be brought to church by November 16 and placed on marked table in fellowship hall. Please follow packing guidelines on what items may be included. (new this year is NO soap). Labels will be available beside the carton of shoeboxes in the sanctuary.

Our goal for HBC is 300 boxes- a real challenge!!

Canned Food Drive

Suggested ideas for “food box” contents

Please make sure there are at least three months shelf life remaining and cans have POP TABS

- ◇ Canned soups (no broth or “cream of”), canned pasta
- ◇ Canned vegetables: (soup, green beans, corn, peas, potatoes)
- ◇ Canned protein/meat: (chicken, tuna, salmon)
- ◇ Canned fruit: (mandarin oranges, pineapple, peaches, pears, mixed fruit, applesauce)
- ◇ Microwave popcorn
- ◇ Snacks: Granola bars-chocolate chip, Crackers (Ritz, Peanut Butter crackers, etc.)
- ◇ Peanut butter (creamy), jelly
- ◇ Spaghetti noodles and Spaghetti sauce (jar/can)
- ◇ Boxed macaroni and cheese and/or pasta salad
- ◇ Cereal, Quaker oatmeal (box of individual packets), grits
- ◇ Muffin mix packets that only require water
- ◇ Bottled water
- ◇ Toilet Paper
- ◇ Paper Towels
- ◇ Personal care: Bar of soap (unscented), shampoo/conditioner, laundry detergent, baby diapers, pull ups, Adult diapers, toilet paper, toothpaste
